Advisory for Malaysian Nationals travelling to India on Carry/use of Satellite Phones

Consequent to the opening of the regular international air travel to India, instances have come to the notice where in foreign nationals (including those holding diplomatic passport) have been found carrying Satellite Phones in luggage.

Under Section 6 of the Indian Wireless Act and Section 20 of the Indian telegraph Act carrying/use of satellite phones, by foreign nationals (irrespective of the category of passport) without prior, approval is illegal and unauthorised.

All foreign nationals planning a visit to India are, therefore, advised to strictly follow above guidelines, and comply with entry related requirements issued by the Government of India from time to time on carrying/use of Satellite phone to/in India.
