ORDER

Electricity Departments of Goa, Chandigarh and Puducherry filed report in respect of operationalization of Open Access in response to JERC Regulations 9/2009 on Open Access.

Electricity Department of Dadra and Nagar Haveli did not file the report.

Commission examined the reports with accompanied documents. Commission heard representatives of Electricity Departments- Goa, Chandigarh and Puducherry. All of them requested time for submitting detailed status report on operationalization of Open Access.

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Request acceded. Commission directed them to submit following information with programme and road map for operationalization of Open Access by 17/7/2012.

1. whether State Transmission Utilities (STU) has been constituted as separate and independent entity? The STU must be a Govt. company for transmission business and should not engage itself in distribution business at all ?
2. whether State Load Dispatch (SLDC) has been constituted as an independent entity with financial and operational autonomy ?
3. Whether STU has been declared as a nodal office of the State / UT concerned for long term open access ?
4. Whether SLDC has been declared as a nodal office of the State / UT concerned for short term Open Access ?
5. Whether STU has prepared detailed procedure for long term Open Access as per the Regulations of JERC ?
6. Whether SLDC has prepared detailed procedure for short term Open Access as per the Regulations of JERC ?
7. Whether business wise / voltage wise asset register is maintained?
8. Details of Consumers having contracted demand more than 1MW be furnished with their names, address and contact number /e-mail as per the format Annexed as mark -A- .
